



Role of Stakeholders

- At local level, registration units are functioning in most of the Government hospitals, where registration of birth & death and certificates are issued.
- Notifiers (such as Aanganwadi Workers, ASHA's , Health attendant etc.) are under the control of Department of Health & Family Welfare and Women & Child development, they are responsible for reporting the domiciliary event to the concerned Registrars.
- The Chief Registrars of births and deaths (Head of the States for CRS) are from Health Department in majority of the States (21), from Economics, Planning and Statistics (12) and in remaining States; they are from Panchayat, Local administration and Revenue department
